

## CAMPAIGN GUIDELINES FOR ILLINOIS REALTORS® BOARD OF DIRECTOR APPLICANTS

The following guidelines apply to all members seeking election to the Illinois REALTORS® Board of Directors:

Although campaigning cannot be prohibited certain absolute prohibitions do exist:

## PROHIBITED ACTIVITIES

- A. Any member named to the Nominating Committee may not be contacted by a candidate about being slated for a position;
- B. Active campaigning in the Board meeting room and during the Board meeting;
- C. Seeking election as a separate full slate or partial slate;
- D. Negative campaigning or comparative campaigning;
- E. Endorsements and/or photographs without the express written release of the parties;
- F. Campaign signage and banners <u>at Illinois REALTORS® events.</u>

## GENERALLY ACCEPTED CAMPAIGN ACTIVITIES

- A. Brochures reflective of the applicant's real estate service;
- B. Website(s) reflective of the applicant's real estate service;
- C. "Vote For" buttons;
- D. Participation at an Illinois REALTORS® sponsored "Meet the Candidates" Forum;
- E. Hosting receptions, <u>if at an Illinois REALTORS® meeting</u>, only with prior approval of Illinois REALTORS®.
