2026 RENEWAL REQUIREMENTS FOR ILLINOIS BROKERS

BROKERS LICENSED

PRIOR TO Nov. 1, 2023

6 hours* of Core CE and 6 hours of elective CE

**Must include 2 hours of Fair Housing CE*

BROKERS LICENSED

Nov. 1, 2023 – Oct. 31, 2025

Three 15-hour courses,
each ending with a 50-question exam

- 12 hours of CE**
(Total including 1-hour SHP Training)
between **May 1, 2024** and **April 30, 2026**

1 hour of Sexual Harassment Prevention training may be included in a course package or taken as a separate course

- 45-hour Broker Post-License**
on or before **April 30, 2026**

*NOTE: The post-license curriculum
Includes the required Sexual Harassment
Prevention training*

FINAL STEP!

Submit your license renewal application and
\$200 State of Illinois licensing fee to IDFPR on or before **April 30, 2026**.

BROKERS LICENSED ON OR AFTER Nov. 1, 2025

Your license expires **April 30, 2028**.
Complete your requirements and submit your
license renewal application and \$200 State of Illinois
licensing fee to IDFPR on or before **April 30, 2028**.

- 45-hour Broker Post-License**
on or before **April 30, 2028**

*NOTE: The post-license curriculum
Includes the required Sexual Harassment
Prevention training*

Illinois licensed attorneys with an “active” attorney registration are exempt from completing all education requirements, but must submit the required renewal fee and application to IDFPR.
NOTE: Licensed attorneys who are REALTOR® members are required to complete Code of Ethics training. Check with your local REALTOR® association about options for that member requirement.

CE earned for disciplinary purposes may not be used toward your CE renewal requirements.
