## **BROKERS LICENSED ON OR AFTER** Nov. 1, 2025

Your license expires April 30, 2028.

Illinois licensed attorneys with an "active" attorney registration are exempt from completing all education requirements, but must submit the required renewal fee and application to IDFPR.

CE earned for disciplinary purposes may not be used toward your CE renewal requirements.

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
